Classroom Rules

1. Treat others with kindness and respect
2. Raise your hand and wait to be called on before you speak.
3. Keep your hands, feet and objects to yourself
4. Be a good listener.
5. Follow Directions

Individual Motivation

Positive behaviors are reinforced with stickers. Children receive stickers to put on their cards. When a child earns 31 stickers, he/she receives a prize from the prize box. In addition, I try to verbally acknowledge positive behaviors all through the day.

Classroom Motivation

A. Stars - At the end of each day your child will receive either a "Star" or "No Star" on the back of his/her hand. (rubber stamp, washable ink)

1. A "Star" means your child had a good day and only needed a few or no reminders to follow directions.
2. No "Star" means your child was given more than one warning that day and was unable to redirect his/her behavior, or your child engaged in unacceptable/unsafe behavior. Please talk with your child about his/her day and remind your child that each day is a fresh start for a better day. If your child loses a star stamp, then documentation regarding this incident will come home in the homework folder. Please sign and return the paper the next day.
3. At the end of the week (Friday through Thursday), five hand stars earn one paper star, which comes home in the homework folder. If your child lost a hand star during the week, then there will be no paper star.
4. Additional possible consequences for warnings given will be as follows:
 - 1 Warning – verbal warning
 - 2 Warnings – miss 5 minutes of the next recess or centers
 - 3 Warnings – miss the next recess or centers
 - 4 Warnings – call home
 - 5 Warnings – go to the Principal and call home.

B. Celebrate! On days when everyone in the class earns a hand star, the class will earn a letter to help spell the word "Celebrate." When the class has earned all nine letters the class will watch a movie to celebrate.
